**A. Summary of Activities**

**A.1 Project Overview**

In December 2004 the Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) adopted the Public Financial Management Reform Program (PFMRP), which is a long-term reform program based on stage/platform approach that addresses the overarching and systemic public financial issues. It remains a sector-wide approach.

On 07 November 2013, Public Financial Management Modernization Project (PFMMP) was established to build on the successes of the ongoing Public Financial Management and Accountability Project (PFMAP). Total proposed project cost is USD 12 million, agreed to be financed by standalone Recipient Executed Trust Fund (RETF), Investment Project Financing (IPF) under the Public Financial Management Trust Fund. The initial periodic contribution from the donors to this trust fund is covering the period from November 07,2013 to May 14, 2016 in the amounts of US\$ 5,903,013 under the Grant No.TF015434.

**A.2 Progress Activities**

The project development objective is to enhance public financial management through two main components: (i) strengthening revenue mobilization strategy and implementation monitoring and (ii) improving budget execution process through the acquisition and implementation of FMIS. Summary of activities under these components is highlighted below.

***Component 1.A: Mobilization of Revenue***

This component facilitates the preparation of a credible and sequenced revenue mobilization strategy for the RGC. During this quarter, the major improvements of revenue policy are summarized as following:

- Conduct several research studies on future direction of garment sector, tax compliance gap in Cambodia, tariff on tourism sector in cooperation with General department of State Property and Non-Tax Revenue, estimated regime policy, tax administration in Cambodia
- Review and revise revenue forecasting 2015-2018 in consistency with strategy on medium revenue collection 2014-2018 and Public Financial Reform
- Review and update Medium Term Expenditure Framework for improving the existing framework
- Finalize General Department Action Plan 2-New for submitting to PFMRP
- Continue to train young economists on Asian Free Trade Agreement, Macroeconomic, Financial Management and at the same time some officials received training on Socio-economic, Econometric Modeling Capacity Building: CGE Model and I-O Table Formulation and other relevant training supported by Development Partners
- Continue to follow up and study the impact on revenue from import taxes regarding ATIGA and ACFTA

### ***Component 1.B: GSC Operation Support***

Based on Sub Decree No. 24 dated 17 January 2014 issued by the Royal Government of Cambodia, General Secretariat of Public Financial Management Reform Steering Committee (GSC) was established by taking over and extending the functioning of Steering Committee Secretariat (SCS). More detail on the organizing and functioning of GSC is shown in Prakas No. 223.MEF dated 05 February 2014.

Concerning the increased workload/organizational structure, GSC has processed in selection of 15 officials for 5 Sections: Policy Group, Revenue Management, Budget Formulation, Budget Execution, and General Support Group & Capacity Building. Following several steps of selection process, 6 officials were successfully selected during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2014.

To support the day-day implementation of PFMRP efficiently and effectively, Vision and Strategy Paper has been developed for GSC containing i) Vision, Objective, Outcome ii) Planning and Budgeting iii) Monitoring & Evaluation iv) Rule & Regulation v) Organizing and Functioning of GSC. The document is already finalized and disseminated for use internally for GSC Management, Official and Contracted staff from July 2014. It may be periodically discussed and updated during GSC retreat in light of experience gained in program implementation and best practice manner.

Furthermore, several meetings and discussions including PFMRSC Meeting, TWG Meeting and Public Relation Group Meeting were conducted with Line Ministries, General Departments of MEF and Donor Agencies. As a result, General Department Action Plan 2-New (GDAP2-New) and Ministry Action Plan 2- New (MAP2-New) have been prepared and finalized. They are officially announced for implementation by the Chairman of PFMRSC starting from July 2014.

In addition to the summary progress of program implementation highlighted above, GSC selected an individual consultant in April 2014 to setup Financial Management Database in Peachtree Accounting Software. The main objective of the assignment is to create a financial management database in computerized accounting system in line with reporting requirement in Project Appraisal Document. New Chart of Accounts is also developed using a uniform account code structure issued in Prakas No. 189 MEF.BK dated 22 February 2013 on the budget classification (six segment classification codes) and subsequent Prakas No. 211 MEF.BK on New Chart of Accounts. In June 2014, the consultant has completely customized the reports and delivered training to relevant finance staff.

### ***Component 2.A: Strengthening Budget Execution Process and Core Treasury System***

FPT Information System was selected as Supplier for the Supply and Implementation of the Financial Management Information System (FMIS) through the contract dated 23 December 2013. FMIS contract was then officially kicked-off on 21 January 2014 and presided over by H.E Aun Pornmoniroth, Minister of Ministry of Economy and Finance. Summary progress of contract implementation is highlighted below:

- Complete the Development of Project Management Plan/Project Plan (PMP), deliverable acceptance procedure for FMIS, test strategy for FMIS
- Establish Change and Communication Network including change agents from central and provincial levels. Draft communication strategy and plan is being reviewed by FMWG.
- Understand current organizational structure, current job roles, responsibilities, and current business processes and current manpower. This will be the basis for change impact analysis and assessment during the construction phase. FIS-LG CNS CM team will continue to support MEF with the change impact analysis.
- Updated Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) in both English and Khmer language and newsletter for publishing to the FMIS Website.

- Stakeholder analysis is an on-going process including: 1) identify stakeholder 2) collect organizational structure and 3) analyze their impact on FMIS
- Review and finalize the As-Is business process and each FMIS modules is to be signed by both parties.
- Following discussion with FMWG and FMIS stakeholder on the agreed tools and templates for the development of To-be process, the first draft was submitted to FMWG on 25 June 2014. Comment and feedback on the draft document will be further discussed before incorporating in the revised version.
- Prepare development strategy to collect and analyze inputs for the development of data migration strategy and plan
- Complete the delivery, testing and installation of two development servers and training facilities related with section 6.4 of Sub-Table 6 and section 5.3.2 of Sub-Table 5 of contract agreement
- Continue to analyze and design Non-ICT System and ICT System`
- Support IT department conduct FMIS Induction Workshop, FMIS Envisioning Workshop and FMIS Change Management Training for senior officials, members of FMWG and relevant stakeholders

#### ***Component 2.B: FMIS Implementation Support***

##### **FMIS Management Plan**

To better improve working process with the Supplier, FPT Information System; the structure of FMWG is revised into Sub-Group based on actual working process. Working place for Supplier and FMWG is located at the 6<sup>th</sup> Floor of Building B, MEF.

A joint FMIS Management Plan has been developed and signed by FMWG and the Supplier, FPT Information System. The Plan includes Master Plan, Gantt chart, Change Management, Training Plan, and Risk Management Plan, Working Plan, Monitoring & Evaluation, Quality Management Plan, FMIS Testing System, and Implementation Schedule.

After locating Main Data Center-MDC, Disaster Recovery Center-DRC, FMWG has continued cooperation with supplier related with Non-ICT survey, server & UPS locations, electrical system and safety system. Beside this, ICT plan is being studied.

##### **Change Management for FMIS**

To get input for change management, FMWG has sought an advice from MEF senior managements and conducted survey at provincial treasuries including Kandal and Bantey Meanchey provinces and also at General Department of National Treasury in Phnom Penh. Furthermore, with the technical support from the supplier, IT department conducted FMIS Induction Workshop, FMIS Envisioning Workshop and FMIS Change Management Training for senior officials, members of FMWG and relevant stakeholders.

The progress of FMIS contract implementation and Newsletter #1 & #2 are updated in the website [fmis.mef.gov.kh](http://fmis.mef.gov.kh). Newsletter #3 is being reviewed for publication, the same as draft communication strategy and plan.

##### **Business Process for FMIS**

As-Is Business Process was completely prepared in May 2014 based on FMIS modules consisting of Account Payable, Account Receivable, General Ledger, Cash Management, Budget Allotment and Partial Purchase Order. The next step is to collect sample reports and recommendation from relevant General Departments as an input for To-Be Business Process. Moreover, FMWG and supplier are paying attention on Unified Chart of Account and Budget Classification.

## B. Variance Analysis by Category Items

The Interim Unaudited Financial Report in this section shows the financial progress under each category of PFMMP by comparing actual disbursed amounts against budget projection in the current quarter. This will inform overall project implementation progress to the Royal Government of Cambodia and the Development Partners. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2014, a total actual disbursed amount was US\$ 106,482.92 comparing with the budget of US\$ 108,309.50. Below summary table provides further information:

**Goods-FMIS:** In the first quarter 2014, the project provided the FMIS supplier 10% of the contract price excluding recurrent cost as advance payment. No budget and actual amount were recorded during this reporting period since there were no much progress against each deliverable outputs within a short period of time after contract mobilization.

**Consultant Service:** The actual disbursed amount of US\$ 77,503.13 was paid to National and International consultants of PFMMP. Comparing with the budget amount of USD 80,398.50, the different was only 3.60%.

**Training & Workshop:** During this quarter, the planned budget of US\$ 7,281.00 was mainly for IT Department conduct FMIS Induction Workshop, FMIS Change Management & Training Methodology and FMIS Envisioning Workshop. The total actual expenditures was US\$6,269.00 or 13.90% lower than the planned budget since the total training days of the three courses were shorten based on actual situation.

**Incremental Operating Cost:** actual disbursed amount of USD 22,710.79 was paid under incremental operating cost comparing with the budget of USD 20,630.00. The recorded different of 10.08% over the budget was mainly due to over spending on office supply and stationery since GSC has a lot of meeting and discussion with Line Ministries, General Departments of MEF and the internal meeting to finalize GDAP2-New and MAP2-New. The increased workload and organizational structure of GSC will also lead to increased disbursement as well.

## C. Summary Procurement Activities

GSC submitted Procurement Plan of PFMMP for Year 2014 to the World Bank for NOL on 12 February 2014 which contained procurement packages for Goods and Consultant Services. After incorporating comments received on 17 February 2014, the Bank provided NOL for only Consultant Service Packages on 27 February 2014.

In addition to NOL obtained from the World Bank on the Budget Plan 2014 dated 23 June 2014, Procurement is updated under Section 3.4 of the IFR. Procurement progress in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2014 is shown in the table below.
